

Einstufungstests zum Lehrwerk ENGLISH ELEMENTS

Das Lehrwerk *English Elements* besteht in der Standardversion aus fünf Bänden: *English Elements – Basic Course* und *English Elements 1 - 4*. Mit *English Elements 4* erreicht man das Niveau des "European Language Certificate in English B1".

Bei den Aufgaben handelt es sich – wenn nicht anders angegeben – um sog. "multiple choice"-Aufgaben, d.h. Sie haben eine Auswahl von Antworten, aus der Sie sich für die richtige entscheiden sollen.

Auch wenn Sie nur geringe Englischkenntnisse haben, müssen Sie nicht unbedingt mit dem *Basic Course* beginnen. Vielleicht reichen Ihre Kenntnisse, um in *English Elements 1* einzusteigen.

• Test Basic Course gibt Ihnen darüber Klarheit.


Bei umfassenderen Vorkenntnissen greifen Sie zu den anderen Testteilen, Test 1A bis 4A:

- Wenn Sie Hauptschulabschluss haben, beginnen Sie mit Test 1B oder 2A,
- bei Realschulabschluss mit Test 2B.
- Bei umfangreicheren Kenntnissen mit 3A oder 3B oder 4A.

Jeweils am Ende des Tests finden Sie detaillierte Hinweise zur Einstufung. Sind Ihnen die Aufgaben zu schwierig, z.B. weil Ihre Schulzeit schon lange zurückliegt oder Sie nach Ihrer Schulzeit mit der englischen Sprache keinen Kontakt mehr hatten, brechen Sie ab und bedienen sich des vorhergehenden Tests. Sind sie Ihnen zu leicht, bearbeiten Sie den nächstfolgenden. Nach **Test Basic Course** sind die Tests fortlaufend nummeriert (**1A**, **1B** bis **4A**) und überprüfen Ihre Kenntnisse bis zum Niveau des **4**. Bandes.

Sollte das Ergebnis des Tests nicht eindeutig sein, steht Ihrem Lehrinstitut auch Material für ein kurzes Gespräch in Englisch, der jeweiligen Stufe entsprechend, zur Verfügung. Fällt Ihnen dieses Gespräch sehr schwer, nehmen Sie lieber einen Kurs, der einige Units weiter zurück beginnt.

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
